## 2024 CY National Invitational 55 & Over Mixed Doubles March 14-16, 2025, Scottsdale, AZ

## Ratings:

All players' ratings will be verified prior to the start of the invitational once rosters are received from the respective section offices.

## Accepted Rating Types:

- Computer "C,"
- Self Rate "S,"
- Computer rated Appeal "A,"
- Mixed "M"
- Tournament "T"

The rating the player played at during the 2024 Championship Year/local season is the rating they must play at in this event.

Examples:

- A player played during the 2024 Championship year as a 3.5 rated player. When YER were released in December of 2024 they were moved up to a 4.0. The player will play at the Mixed 55 & Over National Invitational held in 2025 as a 3.5 rated player.
- A player played during the 2024 Championship year as a 4.0 rated player. When YER were released in December of 2024, they were moved down to a 3.5. The player will play at the Mixed 55 & Over National Invitational held in 2025 as a 4.0 rated player.
- A player played during the 2024 Championship year as a 3.5 rated player. When YER were released in December of 2024, they were moved up to a 4.0. If the player is clearly above level, the player will play at the Mixed 55 & Over National Invitational held in 2025 as a 4.0 rated player.

Any S Rated, A Rated or DQ rated players who are promoted or DQ'd to a higher NTRP level via NTRP Grievance or "Player Promotion" or "Player DQ" any time prior to the Mixed 55 & Over National Invitational held in 2025 must play at the higher NTRP level.

## Waiver Teams: (only accepted at the 9.0 level)

For sections that are unable to produce at least 2 teams in local league play for the 9.0 division, the Championship Committee will allow those sections to complete this form and send one team as a representative of that section. Waivers must be submitted by the SLC by the deadline of January 10th, 2025. Only teams submitted by a section's SLC will be considered for the Mixed 55 and Over Team Waiver.

Any 9.0 team coming via waiver must be comprised of primarily of 4.5 players or higher. If there are no 5.0 players on the roster, only one 4.0 player is permitted.

• For example, a team made up of four 5.0 players and five 4.0 players is allowed for the 9.0 waiver. Only for the 9.0 waivered teams, the lineup cannot have a 4.0 - 4.0 pairing. Teams that are receiving a waiver are limited to a maximum of 10 players.

When waivers are submitted, all players that will participate on that team must be included in the initial submission. Teams receiving a waiver may not continue to add additional players after the waiver has been approved. Substitutions for injured or unavailable players must be requested in writing by the Section League Coordinator and approved by the Tournament Committee prior to being added/changed.

For any team that will be advancing directly to the National League Invitational via team waiver with no local or sectional play, those teams may only have up to two (2) players from outside the section that they are representing at the National Invitational listed on their roster. A player's Section residency association will be based on the player's listed section on their USTA account and the Championship Committee will verify those player's section residencies.
